**DOG/CAT LICENCES:** Residents of the Town of Coronation are reminded that all dog and cat licenses are up for renewal, the cost of which is \$20.00/neutered & spayed dog/cat; \$50.00/intact dog/cat. Please come to the Town Office to purchase your 2019 dog/cat tag.

**BUSINESS LICENCES:** Residents of Coronation are reminded that ALL BUSINESSES, including home-based businesses are required to operate with municipal business licenses. If you are from out of town and conduct business in Coronation the fee is \$100.00. If you live within town limits and conduct business in Coronation the fee is \$50.00. For Home Based Businesses the fee is \$30.00. Please come in to the Town Office and we will be happy to provide you with your 2019 Business License.

- Recycling Grain Bags and Twine
  - Researching Markets
- Conducting a waste characterization study to determine agricultural plastic volumes
  - Surveying producers to get feedback
  - Educating producers
