The Department has had several calls this month with the majority being motor vehicle incidents. During this adverse weather please drive to road conditions and take a little extra time to reach your destination safely, we want you home at the end of the day as much as your family do. Several Department volunteers have been upgrading their licences to enable them to drive the Fire Trucks. In the coming weeks you may see us out and about getting our newly qualified drivers competent in both driving and operating the equipment.

Small Appliances are a major cause of house fires, a few simple steps can greatly reduce the risk.

- When not in use unplug your appliances especially if it produces heat i.e. toasters, hairdryers, kettles – it can't start a fire if it's unplugged
- Choose a suitable location for appliances
- Do not overload your outlets or power boards
- Inspect the appliance and cord for damage

Agricultural Plastics Recycling Update

The Alberta Plastics Recycling Group is in the process of hiring a Program Operator who will oversee the collection and recycling of the grain bags and twine and working to communicate with all parties including the producers on how to bring in their material to the sites, about collection and storage, and transportation to end markets. They are also going to do a market analysis to address the current and future markets for recycling and an updated characterization report about what types and how much plastic is being used.
